SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session on Tuesday, January 15, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. in the in the Board Meeting Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida to establish criteria for milling of roads. Present were Commissioners Robert Brown, Josh Smith, William Mitchell, Beth Burnam and Randy Ogburn, a full Board being present. Also present were County Coordinator Louie Goodin, County Attorney Cliff Adams, Road Superintendent James Bell and Seth Cohen, with NFPS.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith.

Chairman Smith explained that the purpose of the meeting was to establish criteria for milling of roads. The Board discussed how to establish the criteria and set the following order:

1. Dead-end roads with turn around issues, creating the need to back-up.
2. Isolated roads
3. Short & narrow roads
4. Heavily traveled roads
5. Cost of maintenance of roads

Frank A. Smith addressed the Board and stated that he lived near a Church and requested that the Board consider milling the area between the Church and paved road. Mr. Smith also discussed the grading of the roads with the Board.

The Board agreed to prioritize the milling of roads through the Five Year Milling Plan. The Board directed Mr. Goodin to draft a list of the roads that follow the criteria with assistance from Road Superintendent James Bell and meet with each Commissioner in order to prioritize the roads in each district.

There being no further business before the Board, Chairman Smith adjourned the meeting at 5:40 p.m.
