SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session (COVID - 19) on Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. in the Board Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioners Robert Brown, Jimmy Murphy, Richie McCoy and Randy Ogburn. Commissioner Josh Smith was absent. Also present was County Coordinator Louie Goodin.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ogburn.

Chairman Ogburn read the title for Resolution 2021-04 which is the continuation of Resolution 2020-01 the Declaration of a Local State of Emergency due to COVID-19.

- Motion by Commissioner Brown to approve Resolution 2021-04 as a continuation of 2020-01 for an additional seven (7) days. Second was made by Commissioner Murphy, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

County Coordinator Louie Goodin presented the Board with a draft Request For Qualifications for the Board to review for legal services.

The Board also reviewed the drawings from Watson Healthcare for the possible renovation of the old Clinic building. The Board Mr. Goodin to discuss the plans with Building Official John Auer and proceed with plans for the renovations.

Mr. Goodin presented the Board with quotes for an ATV - \$7,039.29 and a UTV - \$12,839.25 to be used for trash pickup.

- Motion by Commissioner McCory to approve the purchase of two (2) ATV's at the quoted price of \$7,039.29 each. Second was made by Commissioner Murphy, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Spencer Nabors, with ITC, introduced his business partner Jeffery Winter to the Board. Mr. Winter reviewed the CDBG-CV grant timeline and projects that could be funded through the grant criteria. After a lengthy discussion, the Board agreed to have the public hearing on February 23, 2021 at 6:00 in conjunction with the weekly meeting to approve the local declaration for a state of emergency.

Mr. Goodin also presented the Board with a draft copy of the Interlocal Agreements for each Municipality for Animal Control Services. The Board agreed for staff to contact each Municipality as to their interest in the services.

There being no further business before the Board, Chairman Ogburn adjourned the meeting at 12:57 p.m.
