**SPECIAL SESSION**

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session on Tuesday, February 16, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in the Board Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida for the purpose of holding a workshop to discuss the Land Development Regulations as they pertain to RV's / Campers. Present were Commissioners Robert Brown, Jimmy Murphy, Richie McCoy, Randy Ogburn and Josh Smith, a full Board being present. Also present was County Coordinator Louie Goodin and County Attorney Cliff Adams.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ogburn.

Chairman Ogburn stated that the purpose of the meeting was to have a discussion regarding the Land Development Regulations as they pertain to RV's / Campers being used as a permanent residence.
