

**MARCH 13, 2024
JASPER, FLORIDA**

REGULAR SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session on Wednesday, March 13, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. in the Board Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioners Travis Erixton, Jimmy Murphy, Robbie Roberson and Richie McCoy, Commissioner Brown was not present for the meeting. Also present were County Attorney Andy Decker, County Coordinator Gary Godwin, Land Use Administrator Mathew Morgan, Fire Coordinator Henry Land, Emergency Management Director Pam Allen and Greg Bailey with NFPS.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McCoy.

RV / CAMPER TRAILERS

Land Use Administrator Mathew Morgan provided the Board with a power point presentation regarding temporary or seasonal camping in Motor Homes or Campers. Mr. Morgan discussed the permit fee verses ad valorem taxes and how surrounding counties currently handle the issue. In the presentation several options were discussed as to how to handle the issues. Fire Coordinator Henry Land discussed a fire call that occurred where several camper sites had no running water, sewer and multiple campers on the property. The Board and those present discussed the current Ordinance and the options available. After a lengthy discussion, the Board agreed to allow a temporary moratorium on RV's and Campers with staff to publish the hearing notice and place on the agenda for the April 2, 2024, Board meeting.

There being no further business before the Board, Chairman McCoy adjourned the meeting at 11:20 a.m.
