

SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session (COVID - 19) on Wednesday, June 24, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. in the Court Room due to social distancing from the Covid-19, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioners Robert Brown, Josh Smith (phone), Beth Burnam, William Mitchell and Randy Ogburn, a full Board being present. Also present was County Coordinator Louie Goodin.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Brown.

Chairman Brown read the title for Resolution 2020-22 which is the continuation of Resolution 2020-01 the Declaration of a Local State of Emergency due to COVID-19.

Motion by Commissioner Ogburn to approve Resolution 2020-22 as a continuation of 2020-01 for an additional seven (7) days June 24th thru July 1st. Second was made by Commissioner Burnam, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

The Board discussed the need to obtain the cleaning services from a professional cleaning company in the event the Courthouse and other County offices require further cleaning due to Covid-19. After a brief discussion, the Board directed staff to obtain the cleaning services and to ensure a rapid response from the company.

Commissioner Mitchell discussed an issue with the Board as to the need for a load of dirt to repair a road with a prescriptive right-of-way. The Board stated that if the issue was on private property that the dirt would not be allowed. County Coordinator Louie Goodin stated he would assist Commissioner Mitchell with the issue.

Mr. Goodin along with Economic Development Director Chadd Mathis addressed the Board requesting assistance with the auction of the North Florida Inn at the Jennings I-75 interchange.

Motion by Commissioner Burnam to declare an emergency and allow the Development Authority to utilize an additional \$200,000 for the auction if necessary. Second was made by Commissioner Mitchell, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

There being no further business before the Board, Chairman Brown adjourned the meeting at 1:02 p.m.
