

**JUNE 24, 2024

SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session on Monday, June 24, 2024, at 10:30 a.m. in the Board Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioners Travis Erixton, Jimmy Murphy, Robbie Roberson and Robert Brown, Chairman McCoy was present for the meeting telephonically, a full Board being present. Also present were County Coordinator Gary Godwin, County Attorney Andy Decker, Fire Coordinator Henry Land and Recreation Director Chuck Burnett.

The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Roberson.

DISCUSSION OF THE FIREWORKS BUILDING

County Attorney Andy Decker discussed with the Board the situation that took place regarding county employees at the Fireworks building at the Jennings I-75 interchange. After a lengthy discussion, Mr. Decker stated that if FDLE does investigate the issue their written report will clarify the actions of the individuals involved. Mr. Decker also discussed an issue with non-conformity of the Fireworks property to the overall conceptual plans for the development of property. Mr. Decker then stated that the new Code Enforcement Officer needs to further investigate the property and submit his final report. Mr. Decker also stated that the individuals involved have done nothing wrong and that the Board and staff stand behind them.

There being no further business before the Board, Vice-Chairman Roberson adjourned the meeting at 11:10 a.m.
