SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of discussing Hurricane Debby in the Emergency Operations Center, 553 Chanbridge Drive, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioners Robbie Roberson, Richie McCoy, Travis Erixton and Jimmy Murphy.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McCoy.

EMERGENCY MEETING – HURRICANE DEBBY

Development Authority Board member Chuck Burnett addressed the Board and advised that one (1) of the Geddes properties needs a survey. Mr. Burnett stated that the company scheduled to perform the survey has stated that they would not be able to complete a survey prior to the closing date set for the properties of Friday, August 16, 2024. Mr. Burnett then advised the Board that NFPS can complete the survey in a timely manner.

- Motion by Commissioner Roberson to declare an emergency and allow NFPS to perform the survey as needed. Second was made by Commissioner Murphy, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

- Motion by Commissioner Erixton to approve the purchase of three (3) utility trailers for emergency operations. Second was made by Commissioner Murphy, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

There being no further business before the Board, Chairman Brown adjourned the meeting at 7:46 p.m.
