SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session on Tuesday, August 10, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. for the purpose of a joint workshop with the Planning and Zoning Board to discuss the amendment to the Land Development Regulations regarding Campers / RV's in the Board Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioners Robert Brown, Josh Smith, Jimmy Murphy and Richie McCoy, Commissioner Randy Ogburn was absent. Also present was County Coordinator Louie Goodin and County Attorney Brittany Cooper.

The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Josh Smith.

PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD WORKSHOP

Vice-Chairman Smith explained the purpose of the workshop as an opportunity to discuss the amendment to the Land Development Regulations as they pertain to Campers / RV's being made permanent residences. County Attorney Brittany Cooper explained the previous draft and the permitting and fees for the amendment. Land Use Administrator Megan Carter discussed the issues with the amendment and the current LDR's with both Boards. After a lengthy discussion, both Boards agreed to allow legal staff to draft a new amendment and be reviewed by both Boards before the advertising process for public hearings begins.

There being no further business before the Board, Vice-Chairman Smith adjourned the meeting at 8:45 p.m.
