EMERGENCY PREPARATIONS – IDALIA

Fire Coordinator Henry Land and Emergency Management Assistant Pam Allen provided the Board with a storm update.

- Motion by Commissioner Roberson to declare an emergency and to approve the Declaration of a State of Local Emergency due to Tropical Storm Idalia beginning Tuesday, August 29, 2023. Second was made by Commissioner Murphy, motion carried with a unanimous vote.
- Motion by Commissioner Erixton to allow the Health Department to close at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 29, 2023, to prepare for the storm. Second was made by Commissioner Murphy, motion carried with a unanimous vote.
- Motion by Commissioner McCoy to declare an emergency and to close all county offices for Wednesday, August 30, 2023. Second was made by Commissioner Erixton, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

The Board also agreed to allow EMS Director Tiffanie Daniels to put a third ambulance on duty through the storm.

There being no further business before the Board, Chairman Brown adjourned the meeting at 12:47 p.m.
