

**SEPTEMBER 6, 2022

SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session on Tuesday, September 6, 2022 at 5:05 p.m. in the Board Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioners Jimmy Murphy, Robert Brown, Richie McCoy, Randy Ogburn and Josh Smith, a full Board being present. County Coordinator Louie Goodin and Finance Director Sheri Davis were also present.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith.

The following business was transacted.

**PUBLIC HEARING – TENTATIVE BUDGET HEARING – 2022 -
2023 FISCAL YEAR**

Chairman Smith opened the Public Hearing at 5:05 p.m.

Clerk of Court Greg Godwin gave the Board an overview of the 2022 – 2023 budget process. The Board discussed the previous changes to the budget and also discussed the possible purchase of a tractor for the Hamilton County Arena. After a lengthy discussion, the Board agreed to allow staff to get additional information and discuss with the Board at the next meeting before making a final determination.

Clerk of Court Greg Godwin read resolution 2022-11 adopting the Tentative levying of ad valorem taxes and resolution 2022-12 adopting the Tentative Budget for fiscal year 2022-2023.

Chairman Smith then closed the Public Hearing and reconvened the Board meeting at 5:50 p.m.

- Resolution 2022-12 adopting the Tentative Budget for Hamilton County for the 2022-2023 fiscal year.

Second was made by Commissioner Murphy, motion carried with a unanimous vote.
