**SPECIAL SESSION**

**EMERGENCY MEETING – HURRICANE IDALIA**

- Motion by Commissioner McCoy to extend the Declaration of a State of Local Emergency due to Hurricane Idalia. Second was made by Commissioner Erixton, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Ms. Allen presented the Board with a letter for signature requesting the County receive mosquito spraying with a forty-eight (48) hour notification through Code Red.
