SPECIAL SESSION

The Board of County Commissioners, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session (Green Point Research) on Friday, September 20, 2019 at 12:15 p.m. at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioners Robert Brown, Beth Burnam, Josh Smith, Randy Ogburn and William Mitchell, a full Board being present. Also present was County Coordinator Louie Goodin, County Attorney Cliff Adams, representative for Green Point Research Raymond Muzzle, Development Authority members Mary Lou Bullard and Nathaniel Combass.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith.

Raymond Muzzle, representative for Green Point Research, gave a presentation as to the company and answered questions from both boards and the public. Mr. Muzzle stated that the project would employ approximately fifty (50) employees and that once the pilot project is complete the company would need an additional property in Hamilton County. Mr. Muzzle also stated that Green Point will be submitting paperwork to staff outlining their assistance request from the county.
