2022 VALUE ADJUSTMENT BOARD ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

The Value Adjustment Board, Hamilton County, Florida, met in special session for the purpose of holding a Value Adjustment Organizational meeting on Thursday, September 20, 2022, at 5:05 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room, 207 Northeast First Street, Jasper, Florida. Present were Commissioner Robert Brown, Commissioner Josh Smith, School Board member Johnny Bullard and Citizens Bill Hunter, and Greg Taylor. Also present was attorney Todd Kennon.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Josh Smith at 5:05 p.m.

The following business was transacted.

VALUE ADJUSTMENT BOARD MEETING

- Motion by Johnny Bullard to appoint Todd Kennon, P.A. as counsel for the VAB. Second was made by Greg Taylor, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

VAB Attorney Todd Kennon provided each Board member with the Florida Statutes governing the VAB procedures.

- Motion by Greg Taylor to adopt the Resolution (VAB 2022-01) setting the VAB filing fee at \$15.00. Second was made by Robert Brown, motion carried with a unanimous vote.
- Motion by Greg Taylor to appoint Commissioner Josh Smith as the VAB Chairman and Commissioner Robert Brown as the Vice-Chairman for the VAB. Second was made by Bill Hunter, motion carried with a unanimous vote.
- Motion by Robert Brown to authorize the Chairman to execute the final decisions and certifications on behalf of the VAB. Second was made by Greg Taylor, motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Mr. Kennon provided each member with contact information and made available the rules, regulations and procedures for each VAB member.
