The Citizen's Advisory Task Force is the liaison between the Citizens and the BOCC.

This meeting with the members of the CATF is a requirement of the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application process. This meeting will be held prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> Public Hearing to discuss the upcoming 2021 cycle.

The County is applying for a \$700,000 CDBG grant and the purpose of this meeting is to obtain the views of the CATF concerning the community's economic and community development needs.

**There are 4 categories that the City can apply for:**

**HOUSING:** Rehabilitation, relocation and new construction for eligible low and moderate income residents.

**NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION:** Utility and drainage, paving, sidewalks, improved lighting, fire protection and numerous other neighborhood and community development projects to prevent continuing deterioration, crime, health and safety problems for low and moderate income residents.

**COMMERCIAL REVITALIZATION:** Improvement of downtown commercial districts to improve business in areas where there is a general decline in commercial activity. Ie: store front improvements, sidewalks, mall-walks, paving, curbing and litter receptacles, utility line replacements and other activities that promote increased business activity that is designed to increase municipal tax bases, create jobs and promote business activity.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:** CDBG funding on a 50/50 public and private investment development project designed to generate business activity through the creation of new jobs to Florida, such as manufacturing plants, industrial park developments, and labor intensive retail businesses such as a restaurant.
